In October of last year, we did an article in this newsletter about a Muslim inmate, Andrew Gaines, located at OSP, whom we led to salvation in Jesus! He was a former leader of a large gang who now desires, and is called to lead many other Muslims to Christ!

At his request, we have been sending him numerous books, Bible studies, and other Christian materials. He has devoured them! He has also been threatened (so was moved to a more secure location), challenged emotionally and mentally, and tempted to return to his former Islam religion and gang leadership—but I want to give you excerpts from the latest letter he wrote me:

I have made a declared decision in regard to my life calling and want to invest myself in evangelistic
