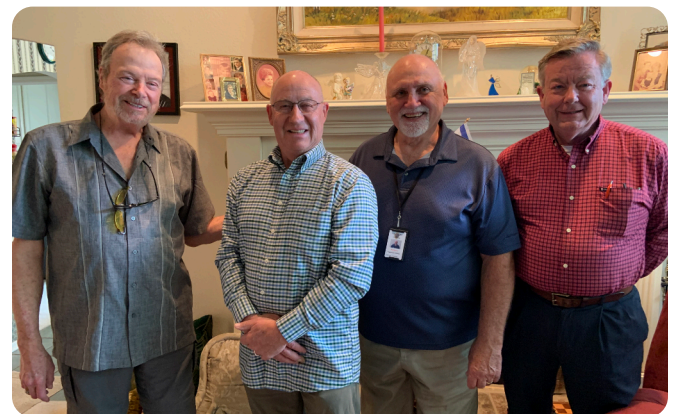
In May, we had 44 men attend our service (that is good for a weekday evening). They were so friendly as they greeted us and told us before and after the service how much they appreciate
