I had been in DHS most of my childhood in Norman, OK, and suffered severe abuse! I am now 32 years old. After DHS, I joined the military and was later discharged. I had become addicted to meth and carried a gun to protect myself from evil men. I trusted the wrong friends and was arrested while getting a ride home because the car was stolen—I had a gun, needles, and meth that the police discovered in the stolen car.

After arriving at EWCC Women's Prison in Taft, OK, I attended Redeeming Love Prison Ministry's chapel service. I went forward when Sharla gave the invitation to receive Jesus as my Savior and
